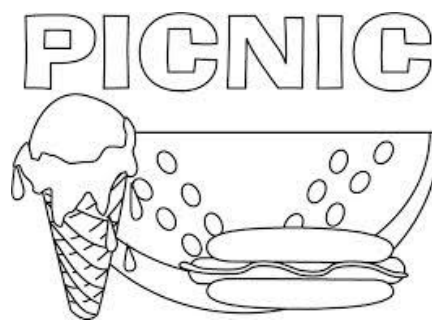
Picnic? What happens at this picnic?
